#### What is Optometry?


Optometry is a healthcare profession focused on the examination, diagnosis, treatment, and management of conditions affecting the eyes and visual system.

#### **Optometrists primarily:**

- Conduct comprehensive eye exams & vision tests
- Diagnose and treat refractive errors (nearsightedness, farsightedness, astigmatism)
- Prescribe and fit eyeglasses & contact lenses
- Provide low-vision care & vision therapy
- Detect and manage eye diseases, injuries, and related conditions






## Optometry vs Opothomalogy

Profession	Education & Training	Education & Training
Optometrist (OD)	4 years undergraduate + 4 years of optometry school	<ul> <li>Prescribe glasses/contact lenses</li> <li>Perform eye exams and vision tests</li> <li>Prescribe medications for less severe eye diseases.</li> </ul>
Ophthalmologist (MD/DO)	4 years undergraduate + 4 years med school + residency (3-4 years)	- Medical & surgical eye care - Treatment of severe eye conditions (cataract surgery, glaucoma, LASIK, macular degeneration, etc.)






